General Event Information

Convention Fees: Cost will be \$25 per member (includes accompanying family). Fees include 1

convention badge (additional badges can be pre-ordered for \$5.00 each).

Fees do include morning and afternoon tea and access to tea and coffee during the

event from the clubhouse.

Fees do not include meals for breakfast, lunch or dinner.

Fees do not include accommodation costs at the club site.

Accommodation:

Our facility is set in a beautiful bushland park setting with opportunity for those who wish to park their motor homes/caravans or for those who would like to pitch a tent.

- There are 20 powered sites available for \$200 (flat fee) for the event. Power is 10amp outlets for use with lighting and fridges.
- Large number of unpowered sites available for \$100 (flat fee) for the event
- Access to toilet and shower block.
- Access to public BBQ's

For those who wish to book hotel accommodation there are several local motels and hotels nearby (a list is included on the accommodation form).

For those paying for onsite accommodation, registration is included for one person.

Catering:

Convention fees do include the following catering which will be hosted by the auxiliary in the clubhouse:

- Thursday 4pm, happy hour nibbles only, drinks not included.
- Friday, Saturday, and Sunday morning and afternoon teas
- Monday morning tea

Lunches are not included in the convention fee. Lunches can be purchased onsite, please note you will need to order your lunch before 11am each day. Other items will be available for purchase including soft drinks, water, snacks, ice creams and club souvenirs.

There are number of restaurants, food outlets and supermarkets in the local area of Edgeworth, Cameron Park, and Glendale where evening meals can be purchased by attendees.

Our Track Information

Our club has an extensive 3,300m of track in varying gauges set in a bushland setting. We do not have multi-gauge tracks but do have:

- Garden Gauge Track
- Elevated 3 ½" / 5" track (800m)
- Extensive ground level 5" track (1,200m)
- Extensive ground level track for 7¼" track (1,300m)
- Paved roadway for road locomotives (600m)

Some fuel such as char/coal is available for use, graded in sizes, located around the steaming bays and station areas. Lighting up wood is available. Water from our taps is suitable for steam locomotives

Track speed is 12kph for 7 % " gauge and 8kph for 5" gauge unless otherwise stated. Please note 7 % " gauge must give way to 5" gauge locomotives. For radio-controlled locomotives, driver must be no further than the first riding carriage away from the locomotive.

Night running is permitted provided adequate train lights are switched on (white front light and rear red light) and there is limited use of sound devices as we are located adjacent to homes, so please respect our neighbours. No whistles after 10 pm.

There will be no public running day during the event.
